

# CLASS I, II, and III AGENCY OF THE YEAR AWARD

## DESCRIPTION

The Texas Public Pool Council (T.P.P.C.) Agency of the Year Award is given to the agency that best demonstrates:

- Significant impact on the youth and families of their local community
- Successful implementation of an innovative existing or new program

This award will be given to an agency who is recognized by the Texas Public Pool Council as having demonstrated effective, quality aquatics programming. There are three classes based on population for which this award will be judged.

**Class 1 – Populations over 100,000**

**Class 2 – Populations 50,000 – 100,000**

**Class 3 – Populations up to 50,000**

## AWARD SELECTION AND PRESENTATION

The awards committee of the Texas Public Pool Council will choose the winner of the award. The TPPC Agency of the Year will be presented at the TPPC Awards Luncheon, January 11, 2011.

## NOMINATIONS

In addition to the questions below, all nominations must be accompanied by a citation of accomplishments (approximately 150 words in length) summarizing the program which is to be considered for the award. **A minimum of four photographs must be submitted with the nomination.** Please also include
